

COLOMBO INTERNATIONAL CONTAINER TERMINALS LTD (CICT) ENTERS INTO A STRATEGIC COOPERATION AGREEMENT ON CONTAINER LOGISTIC DEVELOPMENT WITH ZHANJIANG PORT (GROUP) CO. LTD OF CHINA.

CICT was privileged and honored to be invited to participate in the 21st Century Maritime Silk Road Port Forum held in Zhanjiang, China on the 27th November, 2015 and to enter into a Strategic Cooperation Agreement on Container Logistic Development with Zhanjiang Port (Group) Co. Ltd of China.

Mr. Mohan Wijesinghe, on behalf of Mr. Nelson Liu attended the conference and signed the said Agreement. This was held during the 2015 China Marine Economy Summit.

The Expo is held every year in Zhanjiang City to further strengthen existing relationships and to also implement China's development strategy of "one Belt One Road" .

This also tends to set up a new cooperation platform for countries along the maritime silk road to develop the economy in these regions.

Mr. Wijesinghe delivered a ten minute speech on Terminal Business and Economic benefits of terminal business in Sri Lanka. Mr. Wijesinghe also introduced Sri Lanka and CICT, emphasized the important role CMHI played in modernizing the Sri Lankan terminal business and the key role it played in initially sustaining and then increasing the container traffic throughput of Sri Lanka by developing a deep water terminal.

The audience was also reminded that the Sri Lanka- China friendship was over a 2000 year period with Buddhism and trading having contributed to this relationship.

This was a key factor in entering into this agreement. The impressive speech exerted a positive effect on the conference and increased the popularity of Sri Lanka and CICT as well.
